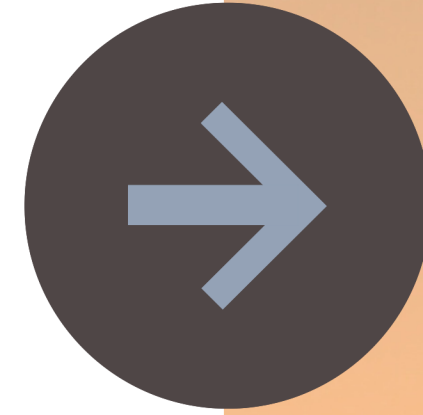

ASSESSMENT

The Goals



ASSESS

We will have assessed the child's experience of attachment, trauma, separation and loss.



DEVELOP

We will have developed an understanding of the child's therapeutic needs to establish and develop the right recommendations and/or intervention programme.



IDENTIFY

We will have screened for impact of early experience on the child(ren)'s central nervous system and identify any neurodevelopmental delays and/or sensory processing issues.



EXPLORE

We will have explored parental abilities and strengths in supporting the therapeutic process and assessed for secondary trauma.



UNDERSTAND

We will have built an understanding of the child(ren)'s and parent(s)' goals for the therapeutic process.

How We Do It

When you come to FSK Minds Matter, you will firstly meet one of our clinicians, whom will manage your specialist assessment process. Our senior Psychotherapist Nicola provides the assessment support work throughout the process. All assessment work will be carried out at 88 Church Road, Stockton.

Additional Information

The structure of the assessment may vary depending on the developmental needs of your child(ren). We may decide to modify the assessment if we feel your child(ren) will struggle to participate in the full Specialist Assessment process e.g. if they are very young, overwhelmed or have recognised learning difficulties. We often incorporate an observation of the parent-child relationship. The standard assessment is an individual assessment.

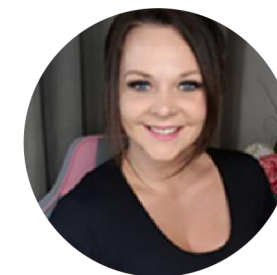

The Therapeutic Assessments are undertaken with two NEATS Therapists present. All assessments are overseen by Dr. Coleen Mercer Quinn, a Chartered Clinical Psychologist. We will arrange meetings, including date, time and location.

(strengths and difficulties)



Neurodevelopmental Screening with Dr Andy Dalziel
(Neuromotor Development Specialist)
(approximately 1.5 hours)



Sensory Processing with Kate Smith
(Occupational Therapist)
(approximately 1.5 hours)



Neurofeedback Screening with Sara Young
(initial meeting approximately 50 minutes)
